

Agreement of Scientific Cooperation  
between  
Center for Applied Mathematics, KAIST  
Taejon, Korea  
and  
Institute of Mathematics, Academia Sinica  
Taipei, Taiwan

To promote cooperative research between the Center for Applied Mathematics of KAIST and the Institute of Mathematics Academia Sinica, we have reached the following agreements:

Cooperation in scientific areas may be designated by mutual consent and the detail of cooperation for any of the identified fields may be specified in the form of addenda to this agreement upon signature by appropriate representatives.

1. Exchange of invitations to scholars for lectures, visits and for participation on conferences, symposia and seminars.
2. Exchange of faculty, research personnel and students for study and research.
3. Joint Research Activities.

The subjects and terms of particular projects as per item 3 above, including their funding, shall be specified in separate agreements between the

parties.

Both parties agree that all financial arrangements necessary to implement this agreement must be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

This agreement is valid for the period of five years from the effective date.


This agreement will become effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of both institutions and approval by appropriate authorities in their respective countries.
